Individual Applications - Sp.G.1-16

The Sp.G. reference code stands for Special Group. The following list shows applicants to the Department of Defence for a special gratuity under Section 41 of the Army Pensions Act 1937. This section of the act covers ex-gratia payments that could be made to persons who received a wound or injury either by reason of the fact that such person was keeping arms belonging to the agreed organisations or by being accidentally shot by a member of one of the said organisations, during the period commencing on the 1st day of April 1916 and ending on the 30th day of September 1923.
