The age limits for 1st Line Volunteers are 17 to 30 years, with extension to
40 years for men possessing trade or other qualifications of military value. The
period of enlistment is FIVE YEARS in the Volunteers with 90 days Initial Training
with The Forces. A Volunteer may have his Initial Training deferred for a period
not exceeding nine months from date of enlistment. ANNUAL TRAINING will be
for a continuous period of nine days which, in certain circumstances, may at the
request of the Volunteer be extended to twenty-one days. Provision is also made
for Overnight Camps, Special Parades and Voluntary Local Drills.

GENERAL

Free uniforms and equipment will be supplied. When in Army service or on
Annual Training Volunteers will receive service rates of pay with free Rations and
Accommodation. Annual Grants in respect of training and proficiency will be
issued; Volunteers receiving up to a maximum of £6, N.C.Os. from £10 to £15,
according to rank, and Officers from £20 to £75, according to rank.

Volunteers considered suitable for training as Specialists or for promotion to
Non-Commissioned and Commissioned rank will be afforded an opportunity to
undergo special training.

3rd Line service is suitable for men not over 55 YEARS who possess trade or other
specialist qualifications of military value and who are unable to join the 1st Line.
Enlistment is for THREE YEARS. NO LIABILITY FOR TRAINING IN PEACE TIME.
