Scope and Content	<p>Correspondence between Mr Maguire and the Military Authorities regarding a number of matters. The first matter in Sept 1922 is an application for a receipt for a uniform to the Judge Advocate General, Cahir Davitt, which Davitt replies he is unable to provide. There is a letter dated 9th November 1922 introducing Maguire to the Adjutant, Curragh Camp where he is to work. There are two doctors sick certs dated 18th December 1922 and 5th January 1923 stating Maguire is unfit for work until mid-January 1923. There is a letter dated 23rd April 1923 from a Mr G Lewis Howe to the Office of the Judge Advocate General looking to make arrangements to meet Davitt to collect articles belonging to Maguire which is agreed to. There is a series of letters dated from the 4th July 1923 to the 25th August 1923 regarding a claim by Maguire for 21 days subsistence allowance when working in Portobello Barracks from the 2nd December 1922 to 23rd December 1922. The claim is disputed by the Judge Advocate General who maintained that Maguire was only present for three of the claimed days. Maguire disputes the JAG's claim and outlines in some detail the work he did. Maguire's final letter includes a threat of legal action. The final series of letters and notes begin on the 24th January 1924 when Maguire writes to Col Hodnett of the Adjutant General's department regarding an assessment for damages done to his office at 10 Chancery Place, Dublin for which an amount of £92 was agreed but had not yet been paid due to the Army failing to provide the required certificate. An inquiry by Col Hodnett results in the required certificate being forwarded to the Army Finance Officer for payment on the 25th February 1924.</p>

Scope and Content	Correspondence relating to the Judge Advocate General (JAG) and legal staff. The first letter is an Army Finance Department Circular No 6 dated 31st October 1922 approving the appointment, on a temporary basis, of officers to work as legal advisors at military courts and as legal officers in the Judge Advocate General's office, and a legal clerk. The circular outlines the salaries payable and rates of subsistence, when appropriate. Five further letters deal with the appointment of individuals to these posts. A letter, dated 19th February 1923, from the JAG to the Adjutant General stating that his department should be considered to have come into existence on the 15th August 1922 and listing the names of officers who have been appointed to positions in the legal department since that date. A letter dated 16th March 1923 outlines that any individual earning in excess of £150 per annum would be subject to income tax. Letter dated 15th May 1923 outlines the rates of pay for the various ranks in the Judge Advocate General's Department - a total of 53 officers, and three letters deal with allowances and officers entitlements. File also includes an Army Finance Circular No 30 giving sanction for the extension of certain temporary appoints in the legal department. There is also a letter, dated 25th October 1923, from JAG to the AG containing a proposal for an establishment for the legal department under the re-organisation scheme outlining the appointments in the establishment and the salary of each officer. The letter also contains a nominal role of officers currently serving in the legal department across the various military commands.
